Rules & Fine Print:

All high school students in the 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade in the US are eligible to participate. A "team" is 2 people. Your high school does not have to have it's own high school fishing team for you to participate.

Each team must register before starting to post. A team must register together with the following information---email both full names, both addresses, both email addresses, both cell phone numbers, and both birthdates to: dtalley@fishingu.com

Each post must include information about your fishing adventure of some type as well as mention Fishing University on the Outdoor Channel & WFN. ALL social media is included- Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, LinkedIn, Pinterest, Feedly, and all others. The 2 top teams across the nation with the highest number of posts will earn the chance to be a star and fish on the show for the \$10,000 cash college scholarship to be used at any school and the \$28,000 scholarship to be used at *Bethel University.

For the Bethel University scholarship, each of the two champion anglers would receive an offer of \$7000.00 per year scholarship, for a total of four years, not to exceed \$28,000.00 in a four year period each, to attend Bethel University and become a member of the Bethel University Wildcat Bass fishing Team, America's premier collegiate Bass fishing program. Each student must meet any and all rules, regulations and guidelines in which to enter class at Bethel University as well as maintain all academic and athletic standards set for by Bethel University and its Athletic Department, its Bass fishing program and coaches. This scholarship offer cannot be used or combined with any other Bethel University scholarship monies unless the total monies do not exceed the yearly scholarship offer above. All students must be approved by Bethel University in order to receive above scholarship. High School student or students winning the Bethel Bass fishing scholarship must have reached the age of 16 years old or have finished the tenth grade of study in order to receive said scholarship.

The \$10,000 cash scholarship is available to the winning team as long as they are enrolled in the 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grade.

More details will be sent to you once you have registered including how the college scholarship will be applied to your college account, etc.
