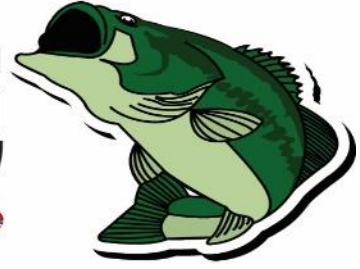

(Check-in & Registration will be on 8/29 @ 4:15 am -Newport Shores Launch Ramp)

5. September 26th Moses Lake – Cascade Marina, Moses Lake
6. September 27th Moses Lake – Cascade Marina, Moses Lake

(Check-in will be 9/26 @ 4:30 am – Cascade Marina Launch Area)

The 2020-2021 Washington High School Series will consist of 4 single day events and will represent the 2020-2021 school year. If the series participation consists of 20 or more, 1 additional High School team will qualify for the 2021 National Championship. The State Championship will be in conjunction with the series and will qualify 1 team to nationals. In order to qualify for Nationals each team will be required to attend the State Championship and at least 5 of the 6 events. The **TEAM** with the **highest qualifying points** will advance to Nationals as the Washington State High School Champions.

- 1. Teams will consist of (2) High School Student Anglers and a Adult Boat Captain.**
- 2. Both High School Student Angler must be a member of a Student Angler Federation Club or Washington Student Angler Federation (WSAF) in order to compete in the series events. WSAF is a \$25 annual membership fee. To sign up to become a member email **Troy Roberts** at tbone-99@hotmail.com or go to **Washington Bass Federation** website www.wabass.org and click on the *High School* link on the upper portion of the page, or sign up at the 1st Series battle.**
- 3. Awards & trophies will be handed out to the top 3 teams. Big Bass trophies/awards for all 4 series events will be handed out at the final event as well.**
- 4. To compete each team will need to pay \$200 entry prior to competition for the year. Or each team may pay \$50/day for all 6 competition days prior to each event.**
- 5. Each Friday prior to Series Battles will be official practice days and competition waters will be off limits the Monday at 12 am morning week of Series Battles.**
- 6. Registration and Check in will take place 1 hr before blast-off. Please contact **Troy Roberts** for any further information. Boat inspections will take place prior to Blast off.**
- 7. Boat Captains will need to provide Proof of Licensing (Boat/Boaters Card) and boat Insurance prior to 1st Series Battle or if a fill in Captain at any time must provide documentation prior to competition.**
- 8. All Student Anglers will need to provide proof of WA State Fishing License before 1st Series Battle.**

**9. All Competition Rules will follow TBF High School Rules.
